Bid Award – North Hollow Rd Bridge

Summary: On April 14 2026, the Town received bids for replacing a failed 12’ span pipe arch culvert with a 40’ precast slab bridge. The culvert was damaged beyond repair during the Jun 2024 severe storms. Bid results are as follows:

All States Materials Group	\$1,086,250
Blow & Cote, Inc.	\$1,197,355

CCS out of Morrisville, was the low bidder. CCS has recently completed construction of two bridges in Nebraska Valley during the 2025 construction season and completed construction of the Dewey Bridge in 2015.

Town Plan & Policy Impact: N/A

Fiscal & HR Impact: FEMA and VT Emergency Management are anticipated to cover 92.5% (\$218,562) of the project cost with the Town being responsible for the remaining 7.5% (\$17,721). The Town continues to work with FEMA on this “Large Project” where reimbursement payments are made based on incremental pre-approved costs as the project progresses. To date the town has spent \$410,000 on emergency response (including construction of a temporary bridge), and design & permitting.

Approximately 125 person-hours of time by Public Works Staff have been involved in the development and coordination of this Project. It is estimated an additional 100 person-hours of Public Works staff will be required to oversee the construction.

Recommendation: Move to approve the award of the Stowe Hollow Rd Culvert to CCS Constructors and to authorize the Town Manager to sign the Agreement on behalf of the Town.
