Memorial Park EV Charger

The Energy Committee discussed the project. Will Fricke said the Selectboard approved the charger placement, and SED and the Town aim to complete the installation this Spring or Summer.

Plans for 2026

It was noted that the Helen Day Art Center is slated for a new HVAC system. Committee members expressed a desire to provide input on the project. Other 2026 goals discussed included the Memorial Park EV charger installation, a student research project, the Town Plan energy section, flex load management program enrollment, the elementary school greenhouse, research on historic district rooftop solar, the Waterbury energy fair in April, another window dressers event, the Stowe Land Trust tree plantings in Dumont Meadows, and looking into whether lights in Town buildings could be replaced with LEDs.
